The cost of education at Alameda Christian is not covered entirely by tuition. During the school year several fundraisers are held to help meet our budget needs. Help from parents is expected and is necessary for the success of these major fund raisers.

October	Walk-a-Thon – Our goal is for every family to raise at least \$200 by asking friends and family members to sponsor your child for the Walk-a-Thon.
November/December	Christmas Tree sale - You can help by setting up the trees on the Saturday after Thanksgiving and by selling the trees for one (or more) 3-hour shift.
February	See's Candy sale - We ask every family to sell at least one box of See's candy bars.
To Be Determined	Silent Auction – We need help getting auction items and we would love to see every family at the auction.

Other on-going ways to help raise funds for ACS at no additional cost to you:

eSCRIP is an easy way to earn money for ACS. You register any one or all of your existing grocery loyalty (Safeway), debit and credit cards for use in the program. Participating merchants (either at stores or online) will make contributions to your chosen group, based on purchases made by you, just by using the cards you have registered. TARGET – If you have a Target REDcard (Target Visa Card, Target Store Card, Target Check Card), you can participate in the “Take Charge of Education” program and designate ACS as the school of your choice. Register online at target.com or call 1-800-316-6142. Target will donate a percentage of all purchases to ACS.

BoxTops4Education - We all shop for groceries, sometimes two or three times a week — or more. Now turn those shopping trip into easy cash for your school, and encourage friends to do the same! Just look for the Box Tops logo on hundreds of products like Cheerios®, Hamburger Helper® and Kleenex®, in almost every aisle of the store.
